## Reception Intake September 2018

Is your child born between 1st September 2013 and 31st August 2014? If yes, you will need to apply for a Reception place for your child.

Anyone who wishes to apply for a place in Millbrook Reception classes for September 2018 will need to think about doing soon. All children, even those who attend the Millbrook Nursery, need to apply for a place through Bucks County Council.

The closing date for applications is 15th January 2018.
